

LAX Statistics Keeper
Version 1.5
Configuring your own report.

While the default statistics report (and corresponding PDF) will work for some users, not all teams want to keep the same statistics and while the CSV files will report all the types you have configured and kept, some really want to see in real time or send it out in a format that anyone can read.

To customize the 6 columns to the right of the players statistics you need to load a file telling the app which statistics types you want summarized in those columns (and what you want to call them).

This is achieved by having a file in the Documents area for the app that it can look into for what you want to do.

The file is a simple text document named "reportStatistics.txt". This file does NOT exist in the default installation, but if it did its contents would look something like:

```
Shot|Shot
Score|Score
Assist|Assist
Save|Save
GB|Ground Ball
```

The part before the '|' (or pipe) character is the title of the column and part after is the statistic (case sensitive) as you entered it in the Edit Types screen.

The actual form used in the application has a more complex format allowing for searches for character strings in the stat type so that it actually gets all statistics starting with 'Shot' instead of exactly that name, but unless you need that, this is beyond the scope of this document. If you feel you need it, send a message to the support line and we will forward a more complete explanation, but you should be prepared to dig into the Apple Documentation for predicate syntax if you really want to use this.

Actual form used in the app:

```
Shot|(type beginswith[c] 'Shot')
Score|(type ==[c] 'Score') OR (type beginswith[c] 'Score ')
Assist|(type beginswith[c] 'Assist')
Save|(type beginswith[c] 'Save')
GB|(type beginswith[c] 'Ground Ball')
```

So, if you want to substitute your own file with your own mappings of the player statistics you want to see you just prepare a text file on your computer that you sync your iPad with, name it reportStatistics.txt and then sync up your iPad.

So, if you wanted to have you stats be Score, SooB, SOG, GB, FW, FW your file could read:

Score|(type ==[c] 'Score') OR (type beginswith[c] 'Score ')

SooB|Shot out of Bounds

SOG|Shot on Goal

GB|(type beginswith[c] 'Ground Ball')

FW|Faceoff Won

FL|Faceoff Lost

In iTunes, select you device, the Apps tab, scroll down to Apps, select the LAXStats app and you should see LAXStats Documents. Use the Add... button at the bottom of that to add you new reportStatistics.txt file to the Documents and browse to your file of interest.

When you start the app the next time, you new columns will be substituted for the old.

This change does NOT change any of the statistics and if you want to change it later, just substitute a new file (or delete it) to get a new version of the report.
